MQHA * FUTURITY MISSION STATEMENT

The Mission of the Missouri Quarter Horse Association's Annual Futurity shall be to promote and reward the breeding of quality American Quarter Horses in the State of Missouri through a futurity to attract the most outstanding Quarter Horse foals and breeders by recognizing excellence in breeding through the distribution of funds and rewards generated from the sale of stallion services donated to MQHA by Missouri stallion owners, friends of the Missouri Quarter Horse Association, and MQHA sponsors, thereby creating a market for the sale of foals and stallion services for Missouri Quarter Horse breeders.

GENERAL FUTURITY RULES

1. All entries must have a stall or pay a \$12.50 per horse, per day jump-out fee—Call Janice Klenke (660-473-1140) for stall reservations.
2. All in-state and out-of-state horses must have a negative Coggins Test.
3. MQHA membership of owner is required at the time of entry. Exhibitor, if other than owner, is also required to be a member of MQHA prior to participating.
4. Only AQHA registered horses or those eligible for registration may be entered.
5. The following must be included with your first payment:
 - a. **A copy of registration papers**
 - b. **MQHA membership fee for owner and exhibitor**
 - c. **A copy of amateur, youth or open AQHA card**
 - d. **Owner's name, address, telephone, and SS number**
6. A \$25.00 office charge will be taken out of all entries.
7. Any payment that results in an insufficient funds check voids the entry. Entries and all monies paid to date shall be forfeited. There will be a \$50 charge for ALL returned checks.
8. No refunds of any kind will be made for any reason.
9. The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, and to cancel any entries, also to disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel awards of prizes, without claims for damage.
10. If any animal entered in any division of the show fails to appear on time, the entry fee shall be forfeited. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to stay informed as to the time the various classes will be shown.
11. Substitution will only be made with a notarized certificate from a veterinarian that the entry was sick, lame or deceased. If substitution is made, the applicable entry fees as of the date of substitution must be made and credit will be given for entry fees already received.
12. The office must be notified in writing of the change of ownership of any entry. A copy of the signed transfer or the registration papers showing the new owner must be included with the request to change ownership. The new owner must be a member of MQHA and meet all other ownership requirements.
13. Horses may be matched for identification and age with the registration papers.
14. All classes will be judged in accordance with current American Quarter Horse Association rules. NSBA rules will also apply in snaffle bit and longe line classes.
15. Tie-breaker judges will be chosen and announced prior to the class. The tie-breaker judge's scorecard will be used to break ties in each class for awards only. The prize money in the tied places will be added together and equally divided.
16. Decisions of the judges will be final. Any act of discourtesy to a judge or to any official of the show on the part of any owner, rider, trainer or groom will immediately disqualify any horse or horses with which they are associated and all entry fees shall be forfeited.
17. Inhumane treatment of any horse will be grounds for disqualification of that horse and all entry fees and awards shall be forfeited.
18. All horses may be asked to submit to laboratory drug testing. Any owner or exhibitor refusing shall be disqualified. Any horse showing a positive lab drug test for any forbidden foreign substance shall be disqualified. All monies earned or paid will be forfeited.
19. All prize money will be paid by check to the individual on the entry listed as owner, unless specified otherwise. Checks will be mailed after the results of all drug tests are received, should they apply. Payback will not be issued unless the necessary social security numbers are supplied. Failure to supply social security number will result in forfeiture of all paybacks.
20. Missouri Quarter Horse Association will not be responsible for any accident or loss occurring to animals, persons or property.
21. The Futurity Committee reserves and retains the absolute right to determine and fully decide any issue that may arise, including any point not covered by any rules of the Futurity, and to make any corrections or make any alterations or determinations as it, in its absolute discretion, may deem appropriate and necessary.

GENERAL RULES APPLY TO ALL PARTICIPANTS AND ALL CLASSES ALONG WITH THE FOLLOWING IN THE SPECIFIC DIVISIONS:

MISSOURI BREEDER'S CLASSES

1. Eligibility for Missouri Breeder's Futurity requires that the sire be nominated and sold through our Stallion auction the year the mare was bred or the year of the Futurity.
2. The stallion owner of each stallion sold receives a certificate of eligibility for one free entry in a Missouri Breeder's Futurity class. Any foal sired by an eligible stallion that is owned by the donating stallion owner may use this certificate as credit against a weanling halter class entry the following year; OR, a hold-over credit may be used for yearling longe line or two-year-old snaffle bit in the appropriate years. A "free entry" designation form must be completed and returned to the MQHA Futurity entry office with an office charge of \$15.00.
3. Missouri Breeder's money will be divided among each class on a per entry amount to be determined at the futurity. The total amount of stallion service money being applied to the futurity will be pooled with the entry money to determine a per entry amount and then each class will have that much per entry in that class. The normal back scale will then apply. For example, if there are 100 total entries in the Missouri Breeder's Futurity, \$10,000 in added money, and 10 entries in the yearling longe line class, the total purse for that class would be determined by the following calculation: $\$10,000 \div 100 \text{ entries} = \100 per entry ; $10 \text{ entries} \times \$100/\text{entry} = \$1,000$ to be split according to pay scale.
4. In the Missouri Breeder's Futurity classes, there will be a \$50 incentive awarded to the highest placing non-pro exhibitor. This money will be taken from the total dollar amount to be given in each class.
5. Ten percent (10%) of the total payout in each class will be payable to the current owner of the stallion that sired each winner.

HALTER FUTURITY RULES

1. Horses will be placed by combining the scores of the three judges. All halter entries will be shown with and must enter the corresponding open halter class.
2. A copy of each weanling's REGISTRATION PAPERS or BREEDER'S CERTIFICATE must be submitted at the time of entry to declare sex and birth date. Early entries will not be accepted without complete paperwork.

LONGE LINE CLASS RULES

1. There will be one go round per class. Each entry will be judged by three judges.
2. An exhibitor may only show one horse in each Longe Line class. The same exhibitor must show both segments of the class.
3. If the horse's chin or nose show signs of broken skin, rawness or bleeding, the horse will be disqualified from the competition.
4. Show management will provide a 5-minute warm-up prior to the start of the event.
5. The Yearling Longe Line classes will be held at the conclusion of the AQHA show on Friday, September 4, 2009. The warm-up will start immediately following the conclusion of the regular show.
6. **EXPLANATION OF LONGE LINE CLASS:**
 - a. Horses shown in a halter, the only attachment allowed to the halter is a longe line that cannot exceed 30 feet.
 - b. It is permissible to use a long whip.
 - c. Exhibitors enter the arena and await the whistle. One and one-half minutes is allowed to exhibit the horse. It is suggested that each horse walk, trot and lope in each direction. If the horse plays on the longe line, it shall not be counted against the horse. The horse is to be judged as a pleasure prospect.

- d. At the end of the time, the whistle will be blown. The exhibitors shall retire from the longing area and remain in the arena until the competition is complete. They will then line up and prepare for conformation judging.
- e. Horses are judged 70% on movement and 30% on conformation. Judges may not discriminate for or against bulk, but rather shall look at the total picture.

PLEASURE AND SNAFFLE BIT CLASS RULES

1. There will be one go-round in all classes. Each entry will be judged by three judges.
2. All futurity entries must show in at least one AQHA class.
3. A non-pro is any AQHA youth or amateur cardholder who meets ownership specifications as defined by the AQHA.
4. Management will check equipment before horse enters the show ring.
5. Show management will provide a minimum 5-minute warm-up period prior to the start of each event.
6. **Note:** AQHA ownership rules will apply to both the Non-Pro Western Pleasure Sweepstakes and to the Youth Walk-Trot Sweepstakes.
