

Missouri Quarter Horse Association Scholarship

Scholarship Application Information Sheet

Purpose: To provide an opportunity for deserving students who are associated with the Missouri Equine industry to further their education in schools or institutions of their choice. The award will be given to students who attain acceptable grades.

Application: Competition is open to all high school seniors. One scholarship will be awarded annually. A second scholarship may be awarded if adequate funding is available. Applications for prospective applicants may be obtained from the MQHA website at www.moqha.com or from the Scholarship Committee Chair, Linda Risner, 911 Creamery Road, West Plains, Mo 65775. Phone: 417-256-5174 (email: risnerquarterhorses@hotmail.com). These forms should be completed and returned to the Scholarship Committee Chair no later than July 1, 2010. Please allow adequate mail time for your scholarship application to be received by July 1.

Amount of the Award: The amount of the scholarship will be \$1,000.00. The scholarship will be for the forthcoming school year and will be paid in the following manner. The amount of the scholarship will be paid to the disbursing officers at a school or institution of the applicant's choice, prior to the beginning of the fall term. If for any reason the applicant does not use any or all of the scholarship, the amount of the scholarship will be returned and retained in the MQHA Scholarship Fund.

Qualifications: (Listed in order of importance)

1. Active participation in the Missouri Equine Industry (such as, but not limited to, MQHYA, Missouri 4-H, Missouri FFA). The applicant must become a member of MQHYA (Missouri Quarter Horse Youth Association) at or be a member at the time of submission of the application. The applicant will also need to provide proof of participation in an equine organization and a letter of recommendation from an officer of that organization.
2. Scholastic record
3. Sportsmanship and General Character
4. Financial Need
5. Applicant's desire for higher education
6. Winner(s) must be eligible for admission to and must enroll in selected school or institution for the upcoming school year.

Requirements:

1. Current official transcript for school presently attending.
2. Recommendation of principal, advisor, counselor, or faculty member from school presently attending.
3. Proof of participation in an equine organization that applicant is currently involved with and a letter of recommendation from an officer of that organization.
4. Membership in the MQHYA

Time of Application: All applications must be completed and received by Linda Risner (Scholarship Chair) by July 1, 2010 for consideration.

All information received in the scholarship application will be treated in strict confidence.

Judges will be appointed by the MQHA Scholarship Committee and will be composed of respected citizens **not** connected with the Missouri Quarter Horse Association. Final decisions are at the discretion of the MQHA Scholarship Committee.
